1. Which of the following is *not* a valid escape sequence?

- (a) \n
- (b) \\
- (c) \~
- (d) \"

2. Consider the following *correct* segment of a *correct* C program:

```
p = 2;
while (p < 2000) {
    p = 2 * p;
}
```

What is the value of *p* *after* this while loop completes its execution?

- a) 1023
- b) 1024
- c) 2047
- d) 2048

3. What is produced by a `for` statement with a correct body and with the following header

```
for (i = 20; i >= 2; i += 2)
```

- a) a syntax error
- b) a divide-by-zero error
- c) an infinite loop
- d) the even values of *i* from 20 down to 2.

4. Which is *not* an ANSI standard library function?
