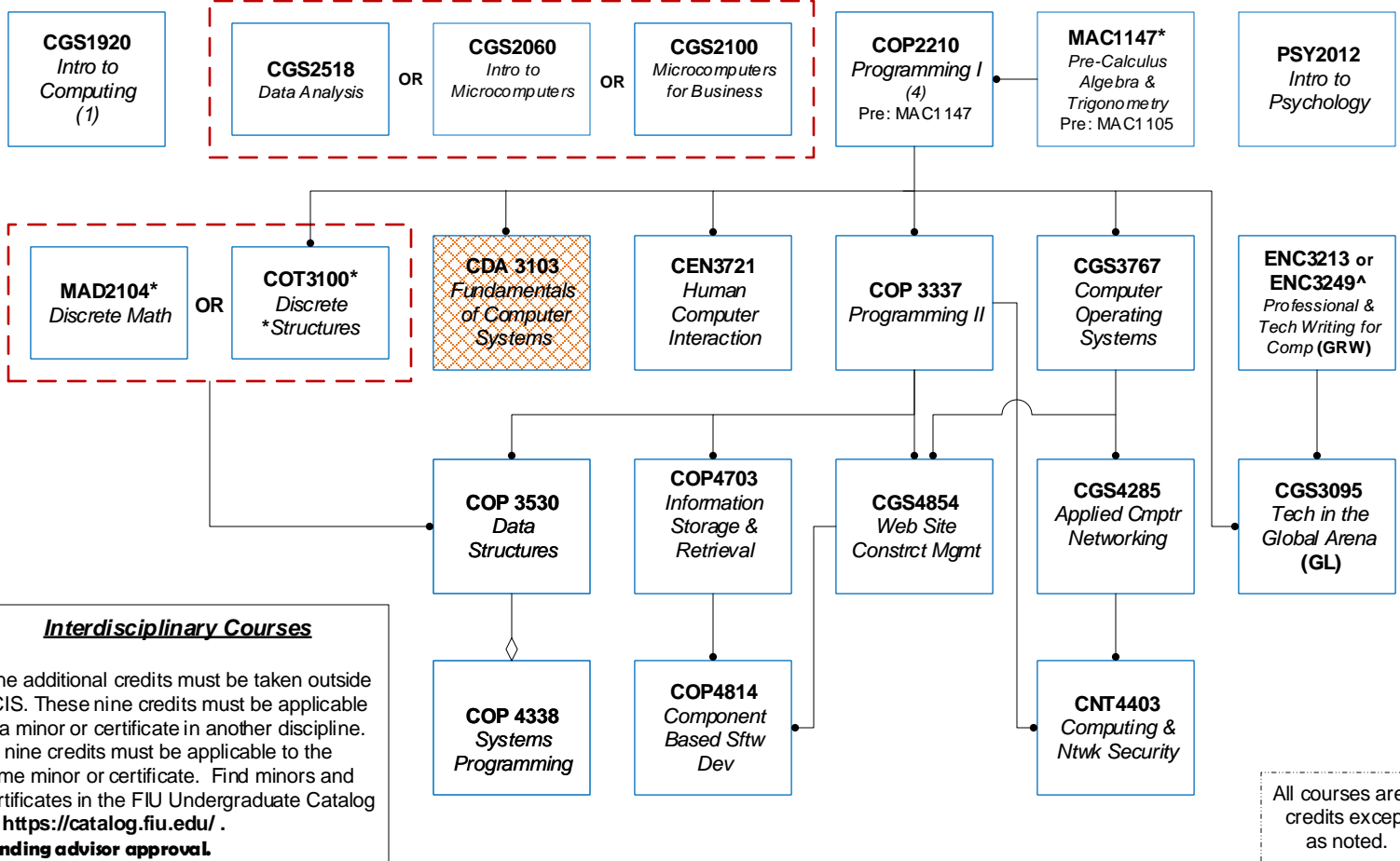

- CNT 4182 *Mobile & IoT Security* (Prereq: CNT4403 or EEL4806)

System Administration

- CIS 4431 *IT Automation* (Co-req: CGS4285)
- CNT 4603 *Windows System Admin* (Prereq: CGS3767)
- CTS 4348 *Unix System Admin* (Prereq: CGS3767)

Application Development

- COP 4005 *Windows Prmg for IT* (Prereq: COP3337 & CEN3721, Co-req: COP4703)
- COP 4655 *Mobile Appl Prgm* (Prereq: COP4814 & CEN3721)
- COP 4813 *Web Appl Prgm* (Prereq: COP4005 & CGS4854)
